# Messages/Traffic:

26 messages handled 34 Skywarn reports

#### Other:

- Several reports were handed to PEMA on the 3.9935 frequency.
- Progress reports were sent to WPA SM on 3.983
- Some of the above messages were HF Digital to NCS and then voice to PEMA or ARC
- Since the American Red Cross did not participate we were not able to send shelter reports to their headquarters. Those ended at Net Control.
- The 146.85 repeater was taken off the air for 10 minutes by Trustee K3YV to simulate loss of the machine. Stations switched to 146.76 quickly and returned to 85 when it returned. The dilithium crystals were knocked off line by lightening and had to be rebooted.
- ICS-213 forms were used for all messages. Planning was accomplished using ICS-201, 205, and 205A forms prior to the event.

#### **Observations:**

The exercise went well. Stations operated with good net discipline and messages were timely relayed. There were multiple points of contact on multiple frequencies and this is the first time Skywarn was integrated into a drill in Centre County. Messages were 'manufactured' by the participating stations at shelters and out of County. They did an excellent job of creating messages that simulated real traffic for such a situation. This included an elephant trapped in a closet at a local retirement village.
